Pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court M.R.18368, In re: Mandatory Electronic Filing in Civil Cases, and in furtherance of the statewide mandate for all civil cases to be conducted by E-filing effective January 1, 2018, the Court hereby orders as follows:

Effective September 1, 2017 all Asbestos Law cases, Civil Law cases in excess of \$50,000.00 and Arbitration cases shall be mandatory e-file for all attorneys.

Effective October 1,2017 all Divorce and Legal Separations, Law Magistrate including Forcible Entry and Detainers, Small Claims and Adoptions cases shall be mandatory e-file for all attorneys.

Effective November 1, 2017 all Family, Chancery, Miscellaneous Remedies, Eminent Domain and Municipal Corporation cases shall be mandatory e-file for all attorneys.

Effective December 1, 2017 all Orders of Protections, Tax, Probate, Mental Health shall be mandatory e-file for all attorneys.

Effective December 1, 2017, Self-represented litigants will also be required to e-file documents filed in all civil cases unless they are exempted from this rule by Court order for good cause. The Circuit Clerk's office will provide work stations for e-filing within the courthouse.

The Madison County Circuit Clerk shall only accept, file or docket documents in civil cases that are filed in compliance with this Administrative Order, unless a party or document is exempt pursuant Supreme Court Rule or exempt per Court order for good cause shown.

It is further ordered that this Administrative Order be filed in the Office of the Circuit Clerk of Madison County, Illinois and that said order be made available to the members of the bar and public.
