### **DETENTION HOME:**

He reported the highest daily population was 31 with an average daily population of 25, the average daily out of county population was 8 and the average female population was 8. He also reported that the department received a grant from Ameren to replace the griddle and dishwasher at no cost. They are also replacing the lighting with LED at no cost as well.
